



General Installation Instructions – Floor Graphics

1. Installation must be performed by a **licensed, professional installer**.
2. **Vacuum** the rubber flooring to ensure that it is free of all dust, lint and any other particles.
3. **Clean** the rubber floor surface with a warm, soapy water mixture **using mild dishwashing liquid**.
4. It's very important that **proper placement** of the logo occurs on the **first attempt**. While the floor graphic can be adjusted or repositioned, **maximum bonding** can only be achieved if the floor graphic is not adjusted or repositioned.
5. **Larger floor graphics** (> 3' wide) require **two installers**.
6. Using the **squeegee** enclosed with the floor graphic, **apply even and firm pressure** from the center of the floor graphic out toward each edge to **remove all air bubbles**. **Repeat this step** across the entire floor graphic to ensure proper adhesion and aesthetics. Pay **special attention** along the edges of the floor graphic.
7. Allow the adhesive to **cure for 24 hours**. **Repeat the step described in Step 6**, squeegeeing from the center out paying special attention to the edges of the floor graphic.
8. Allow the adhesive to **cure for another 24 hour period**. Following this second curing period, normal foot traffic, exercise and other activities are permissible and need not be restricted.
